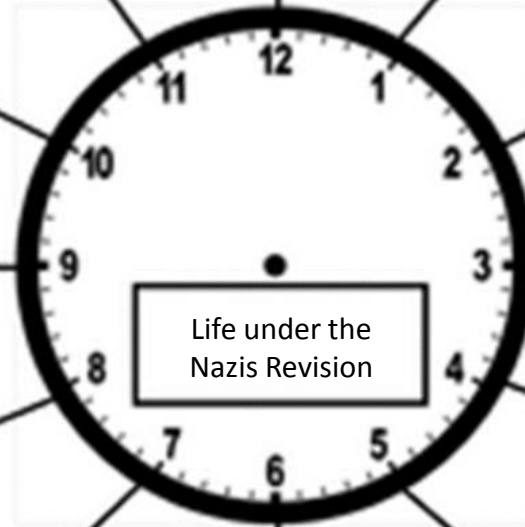
Choose Nuremberg Laws or Kristallnacht. Explain how it was a turning point in the treatment of Jews.
